

WEEE Return of old equipment

According to Directive 2012/19/EU of the European Parliament and of the Council of 4 July 2012 on waste electrical and electronic equipment (WEEE) and the amendment to the German Electrical and Electronic Equipment Act (ElektroG3), there is an obligation to collect WEEE and to treat and dispose of it in accordance with the regulations. This means that every producer is obliged to provide a reasonable possibility for the return of WEEE from users other than private households (B2B equipment).

FISCHER Mess- und Regeltechnik GmbH takes responsibility for its products and feeds them into a high-quality recycling process after use. We therefore offer our customers the take-back of our products.

For the protection of persons and the environment, all equipment and components must be cleaned and decontaminated before they may be shipped. A legally binding declaration on the condition of the equipment must be enclosed with the consignment. We will only accept a consignment if we have this declaration completed in full and signed.

To dispose of an electrical appliance purchased from FISCHER Mess- und Regeltechnik GmbH correctly, proceed as follows:

1. Clean and decontaminate the unit.
2. Pack the unit and select suitable transport packaging for it.
3. Complete the return form in full and enclose it with the shipment.
4. Commission a forwarding agent or a parcel service with the shipping.
5. Sign the legally binding declaration.
