REACh (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals)

Dear Sir or Madam,

The European Regulation No 1907/2006 "REACh" (Registration, Evaluation, Authorisation and Restriction of Chemicals) entered into force on June 1, 2007. The REACh Regulation governs the use of chemical substances within the European Union, in particular those identified as substances of very high concern (SVHC).

As a manufacturer of products in accordance with REACh, FISCHER Mess- und Regeltechnik GmbH is classified as a downstream user. Our products are thus exempt from compulsory registration and evaluation as well from authorisation requirements. In manufacturing our products, we do not exceed the quantity of one ton per year in respect of substances/chemicals in the SVHC Candidate List.

Moreover, under normal and foreseeable conditions of use, no such substance is released from our products. Accordingly, FISCHER Mess- und Regeltechnik GmbH is not under registration obligations or the obligation to compile safety data sheets.

In pursuance of Article 33 of the REACh Regulations, FISCHER is under obligation to furnish information to its customers if a product contains more than 0.1 mass percentage of a substance in the SVHC Candidate List (<https://echa.europa.eu/de/candidate-list-table>).

On 27.06.2018 lead (CAS No. 7439-92-1) was admitted to the SVHC Candidate List.

Accordingly, we herewith furnish information to the effect that our assemblies and components manufactured from aluminium alloys, brass or steel (not stainless steel) reveal a lead alloy content, as a rule in a standard industrial weight industrial weight concentration of >0.1 mass percentage.

If and when required, we will provide you with name of the relevant substance for the product in the forms of a Manufacturer Declaration.

Our statements reference exclusively to our current state of knowledge and are based on the information provided by our suppliers. We assume no warranty or liability for factors beyond our knowledge and control. Accordingly each and every user is obliged to check, at its own responsibility, the intended field of application and relevant purpose of use, observing special features, if any.
